To say one of the greats of our breed is gone does not serve Eric of his true legacy left to the Great Dane and everyone whose lives he touched. Eric was to be one of the judges at the GDCA SE Division Specialty this year. To pen his life's story in a few words is impossible.

Eric passion for Great Danes began in 1970 where after attending a show a week later he found himself at the famed Dinro Kennels where his first dane, "Royal" set him on his astounding future. As a youth Eric piloted his dane to numerous wins as well as qualifying for the Junior Showmanship finals twice at Westminster Kennel Club. His passion grew and he the lived with Rose Roberts of Dinro Kennels and learned the art of breed and exhibiting.

Knowing he wanted to continue in the sport he began showing dogs professionally after college. His winning began from the beginning, and he piloted some of the nation's greatest dogs on each coast to the top of the rankings. From there he was offered a position with the American Kennel Club and worked in the education department producing breed videos for all breeds. He was a sponge, a man with the most remarkable memory. To him, he was in heaven being able to meet breeders from all breeds and learning every day. The natural progression from there was for Eric to become a judge. He was well received by his peers and judged, Great Danes, as well as numerous groups. He was bestowed the honor of judging the GDCA numerous times. It is with such sadness that Eric Ringle is not with us today as he was once again asked to judge our national. The sport has lost an icon, not only in our breed but the entire sport. He is missed and we honor him by dedicating this show to him.

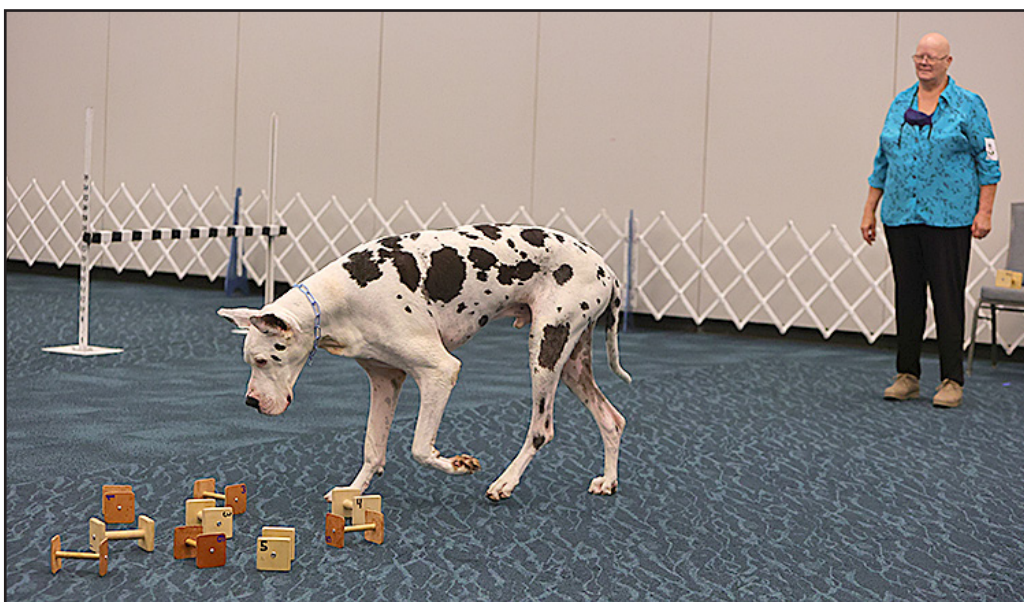
