STANDARD COMMITTEE REPORT *Sharon Fulford-Fint*

The Standard Committee members, Sharon Fulford-Fint, Chmn, Jason Hoke, Pres, Neil O'Sullivan, Bob Layne, Sue Shaw and Pat Ciampa wish to sincerely thank all those who contributed and sent comments to the AKC and the to the committee regarding the proposed revision to the Official Great Dane Standard. All submissions were reviewed and considered. Also to the attendees at the General Membership Meeting in Chandler, we listened! The passionate and powerful message was most encouraging!

Your experience, care and concern for the betterment of the breed, the need for ongoing education of approved judges and those who will apply in the future, has helped us to create an updated standard that we believe will benefit all breeders as well. The revision will now include a much stronger emphasis on Conformation and Breed Type, the Solid and Mantle Merle and related section changes, separation of Color from Patterns/Markings, changes to the description of Proportion, Changes to Bite and General Appearance regarding true Dane breed type.

The period wherein further comments may be sent to Mari Beth O'Neill at the AKC, or to Sharon chimotxc@gmail.com and Jason jasonhoke@aol.com expires at the end of November. After that, the Standard Committee will meet again and consider final changes. Mari Beth will have the proposed revisions go back to the AKC Board at the January 2018 meeting, to grant approval for the GDCA to ballot the membership.

The Proposed Standard Revision approved by the Board 11-2-17, is included below. We strongly encourage continued comments and suggestions that may help us to define our vision for the future of our beloved Great Danes!

GDCA STANDARD REVISION – VOTING BLOCK VERSION OCOTBER 17, 2017

1.) Proportion Change

Under Size Proportion and Substance:

<u>Change:</u> In ratio between length and height, the Great Dane should be square. In bitches, a somewhat longer body is permissible, providing she is well proportioned to her height.

To: The Great Dane is square when measured from the highest point of the withers to the ground, as compared to the point of shoulder to the point of buttocks. A weak topline or a long loin is a serious fault.

2.) Changes to Bite

Changes under Head:

<u>Change</u>: Teeth shall be strong, well developed, clean and with full dentition. The incisors of the lower jaw touch very lightly the bottoms of the inner surface of the upper incisors (scissors bite)

To: Teeth shall be strong, well developed, clean, and with full dentition preferred. The incisors of the lower jaw touch very lightly the bottoms of the inner surface of the upper incisors (scissors bite)

<u>Change</u>: And undershot jaw is a very serious fault. Overshot or wry bites are serious faults.

To: An Overshot bite is a serious fault. Undershot and wry mouths are very serious faults.

3.) Merle Addition

<u>Change</u>: Eyes: In Harlequins, the eye should be dark: light colored eyes, eyes of different colors and walleyes are permitted but not desirable.

To: Eyes: In Harlequins and Merles, the eyes should be dark; but blue eye(s) and eyes of different colors are permitted.

<u>Change</u>: Nose: A black spotted nose is permitted on the Harlequin; a pink colored nose is not desirable.

To: Nose: A black spotted nose is permitted on the Harlequins and Merles; a solid pink color nose is not desirable.

<u>Change</u>: The nails should be short, strong and as dark as possible, except that they may be lighter in Harlequins.

To: The nails should be short, strong and as dark as possible,

except that they may be lighter in Harlequins, Mantle Blacks and Merles.

<u>Change</u>: The hindquarters shall be strong, broad, muscular, and well angulated, with well let down hocks. The nails should be short, strong, and as dark as possible, except that they may be lighter in Harlequins.

To: The hindquarters shall be strong, broad, muscular, and well angulated, with well let down hocks. The nails should be short, strong, and as dark as possible, except that they may be lighter in Harlequins, Mantle Blacks and Merles.

Change:

Brindle: - The base coat shall be yellow gold and always brindled with strong black cross stripes in a chevron pattern. A black mask is preferred. Black should appear on the eye rims and eyebrows, and may appear on the ears and tail tip. The more intensive the base color and the more distinct and even the brindling, the more preferred will be the color. Too much or too little brindling are White equally undesirable. markings on the chest and toes, black-fronted, dirty colored brindles are not desirable.

To:

Brindle

Color: The base color shall be yellow gold and always black brindled stripes.

Patterns/Markings: Brindle with a black chevron pattern with a black mask. Black should appear on the eye rims and eyebrows, and may appear on the ears and tail tip. The more intensive the base color and the distinct and more evenly brindled, the more preferred will be the color. Too much or too little brindling are equally undesirable. White markings on the chest or toes, black-fronted, dirty colored brindles are not desirable.

Change:

Fawn: The color shall be yellow gold with a black mask. Black should appear on the eye rims and eyebrows, and may appear on the ears and tail tip. The deep yellow gold must always be given the preference. White markings at the chest and toes, blackfronted dirty color fawns are not desirable.

To:

Fawn

Color: The color shall be yellow gold.

Patterns/Markings: Black should appear on the eye rims and eyebrows with a black mask, and may appear on the ears and tail tip. The deep yellow gold must always be given preference. White markings on the chest or toes, black-fronted dirty colored fawns, are not desirable.

Change:

Blue: The color shall be a pure steel blue. White markings at the chest and toes are not desirable. **To:**

Blue

Color: The color shall be a pure steel blue.

Patterns/Markings: White markings on the chest or toes are not desirable.

Change:

Black: The color shall be glossy black. White markings at the chest and toes are not desirable.

To:

Black

Color: The color shall be a glossy black.

Patterns/Markings: White markings on the chest or toes are not desirable.

Change:

Harlequin: Base color shall be pure white with black torn patches irregularly and well distributed over the entire body; a pure white neck is preferred. Merle patches are normal. No patch should be so large that it appears to be a blanket. Eligible but less desirable, are black hairs showing through the white base coat which give a salt and pepper or dirty appearance.

To:

Harlequin

Color: Base color shall be white with black torn patches, merle patches are normal.

Patterns/Markings: Black torn patches well distributed over the entire body; with whole or partial white neck. No patch should be so large that it appears to be a blanket. Eligible but less desirable, are black hairs showing through the white base coat which gives a salt and pepper or dirty appearance.

Change:

Mantle: The color shall be black and white with a solid black blanket extending over the body; black skull with white muzzle; white blaze is optional; whole white collar is preferred; a white chest; white on whole or part of the forelegs and hind legs; white tipped tail. A small white marking on the blanket is acceptable.

To:

Mantle Black

Color: Black and white with a black blanket extending over the entire body

Patterns/Markings: Black skull with white muzzle, white blaze is optional, whole or partial white neck, a white chest, white on whole or part of the forelegs and hind legs, white tipped black tail. A small white break in the blanket is acceptable. Black pigment may be seen on the skin in white areas.

ADD:

Merle

Color: A pale gray to dark gray merle base color with black torn patches within.

Patterns/Markings: May be Solid Merle (white on chest and toes not desirable) or Merle with a Mantle Pattern (solid merle blanket extending over the body, merle skull with a white muzzle, white blaze is optional, whole or partial white neck, a white chest, white on whole or part of the forelegs and hind legs, white tipped merle tail. A small white break in the blanket is acceptable. Black pigment may be seen on the skin in white areas.)

DQ: Merlequin, a white dog with "only" patches of merle.

<u>Change</u>

Any variance in color or markings as described above shall be faulted to the extent of the deviation. Any Great Dane which does not fall within the above color or pattern classifications must be disqualified.

To:

Faults of Patterns/Markings shall NOT carry as much weight as faults of conformation and breed type. Any variance in Patterns/Markings as described in the above colors shall be faulted to the extent of the deviation.

Any <u>COLOR</u> other than the seven described shall be disqualified.

<u>Change</u>: Disqualifications: Danes under minimum height Split nose Docked tail Any color other than those described under" Color Marking and Pattern"

To:

Disqualifications: Danes under Minimum Height Split nose Docked tail Any <u>COLOR</u> other than the seven colors described Merlequin

4.) General Appearance

Change: Lack of true Dane breed type, as defined by this standard, is a serious fault

To:

Lack of true Dane breed type, as defined by this standard, is the <u>most</u> serious fault

A resident of Tucson for the past 35 years, Linda passed away at home after years of fighting multiple cancers, lung, and heart disease. Survived by husband, Michael, son, Steven Clark (Beth), and daughters,Traci Meske (John) and Ashlee Hunt (Randy). She was a wife, mother, grandmother and great grandmother of 3. She is also survived by two sisters, Roberta Cushing and Nancy Sallee (Ralph).

She was preceded in death by her parents and grandson Bradley. Her love of her Great Danes and her family were her priorities, and her passion. She will be missed by all. Phyllis Constance (Paddy) Magnuson~ Danes of Magnus 1925 - September 4, 2017. Honorary Member of the GDCA, for her service to the Club and to our breed.

Breeder Owner Handler of the 2008 Winners Bitch/Best of Winners at the GDCA National Specialty, Mochree Irish Melody v Magnus. Born Phyllis Constance Shaw in Belfast, Northern Ireland in 1925, and known as Paddy from infancy, Mrs. Magnuson was the fourth of six children Shaw. born to Ethel Dorman а businesswoman, and James Wesley Shaw, a celebrated motorcycle racer. Paddv attended the Richmond Lodge School (now Victoria College) in Belfast and grew up during World War II when Belfast was bombed numerous times by the Luftwaffe. She emigrated to the United States in 1948 along with her parents and younger sisters.

Soon after arriving in Montclair, New Jersey, Paddy and her younger sister, Mrs. Victoria Berry, known as Fay, headed west, to La Jolla, California, and Yellowstone National Park, Wyoming. Both were employed at Yellowstone's Old Faithful Inn. Paddy's photo albums from that period document a love for the wilderness and the cultivation of many friendships. Her travels also led Paddy to John Magnuson, her husband of 51 years, who predeceased her in 2012. John's post as a professor in SUNY Delhi's hospitality department brought the couple to Delhi in 1969.

A gifted amateur tennis and badminton player, Paddy competed as a singles and doubles player, often partnered with Fay. But a childhood spent surrounded by animals developed into a 50-year-long passion for breeding, raising, and showing Great Dane dogs. Under the kennel name Magnus Danes. Paddy bred manv champions, including most recently, Seanachai, Irish Mooch of Magnus, (known as Seani) and Mochree, Irish Melody of Magnus, known as Madi, brother and sister, whose dam, Rockbridge Charli-Angel, known as Charli, was Paddy's most successful champion. Seani and Madi survive Paddy, and have been placed in loving homes near Delhi.

In a column she authored for the Great Dane Club of America, Paddy wrote "there is nothing more gratifying than raising a beautiful, healthy litter and seeing them float around the ring, or fly through an agility course with the grace and swiftness of an antelope. It takes experience, dedication, and a continuing search for knowledge to reach such gratification."

Paddy was a regular contributor to publications and websites related to Great Danes. Entries to her column "Words of Wisdom" (http://www.gdca.org/wordsofwisd om.html) are still accessible online. Until as recently as 2012, Paddy was a sought-after Great Dane show judge; she also promoted the certification of therapy dogs. In addition, she was an advocate for the proper care and treatment of animals in general, serving on the board of and as an obedience trainer for the Heart of the Catskills Humane Society.

Humane Society Director Deb Crute described Paddy as an ardent supporter of animals and a dear friend, saying she was "a spunky, intelligent, and incredible woman who will be missed greatly by many people—and animals—in the community."

"We should all be so fortunate to have had Paddy, or anyone even remotely like her, in our lives," she added.

Strong in her opinions, her politics, and the proper treatment of animals, Paddy lived as she wished, independently with her handsome dogs beside her, until her death.

In addition to her husband, Paddy was predeceased by four of her five siblings, Wesley Shaw, Maureen Livesey, Joan Bulloch, and Barbara Boyd, and her niece Yvonne Shaw. She is survived by her sister Fay Berry; her nieces Sharon Livesey, Joan Livesey, Patricia Berry, and Victoria Robinson; and her nephews Richard Shaw, Douglas Shaw, Robert Livesey, Michael Berry, Stuart Boyd, and Steve Boyd.

The realities of the sport of dogs is that many successful breeders become breeder-judges. For those of you that have thoughts of following that path I want to give you some useful information.

Prior to registering for a GDCA sponsored Judges Ed program it is necessary for you to have completed the three basic goals required by the AKC to apply to judge in your primary breed. These would be 12 or more years in the breed, 5 or more litters and 4 or more champions. It is also important that you plan to submit your application to judge within 12 months of the Judges Ed presentation. The AKC puts a shelf-life on how long they will recognize your attendance at one of these programs. If, for example, you do not apply to judge for 3 years after attending a Judges Ed program you may be required to attend another program.


