The activity with dog shows continues to expand. There are still some issues with regards to indoor venues. Outdoor events seem to be almost without any cancellations, at least in my part of the country (Southeast) and the entries have often been the largest in the history of some clubs. Many Great Dane clubs have done some creative thinking and managed to find an outdoor venue versus their normal indoor events. I know my affiliate club had to recreate their Specialties last year. They found an outdoor facility which allowed them to have four Specialties in two days. It worked out very well and they are going to repeat this procedure in 2021. The demand for Sweepstakes judges is, therefore, about as active as ever, if not more so. Many people are aware that somewhere there is a list of GDCA members that need Sweeps assignments but they often can't remember where to find it. I will frequently get a call asking me if we still have such a list. Here is the info which I would hope every affiliate club is using to obtain their Sweeps judges...

BREED MENTORS

The rejuvenation of dog show activity brings with it a number of people that have not been able to obtain the required mentorship from an approved GDCA mentor. I have personally been involved with a couple situations in recent weeks where I was able to find a mentor for people that are trying to do it the right way. Mentoring an individual at an outdoor event does not present much in the way of problems. Indoor events can be a bit trickier. Depending on the individual show they may not allow ringside seating ("show-and-go"), no ringside assembly, etc. There is little we can do to change the Covid protocols that are in place. I have personally been at indoor shows in the last couple months where the protocols have been vastly different. I have been receiving the Notice of Mentoring Forms from some of our mentors so I know that we are continuing to do this most important work. A special thanks to those mentors that vear in and vear out seem to go out of their way to find opportunities to help people learn our breed from someone with exemplary qualifications.

GDCA Irish Spotting Test Validation Study Mary Anne Zanetos

As of April 7, 2021, 167 of the planned 200 Great Danes have been enrolled.

We will be following up with owners who enrolled but have not ordered their test kits or submitted a sample to VGL.

Although the data are limited at this time there are some trends:

 45% of the Great Danes enrolled had prior color testing. This probably reflects either an interest in genetics or a bias as to the importance of producing desirable markings on the part of owners who enrolled in the study.

- Participation by well-known "color" breeders in the US, and/or persons who've commented on color and pattern revisions to the standard has been lower than expected.
- Enrollment of popular harlequin or mantle stud dogs has been lower than anticipated.
- Some owners register phenotypically piebald or white (double harlequin) Great Danes as harlequins. There also seems to be confusion about the likely genotype of mostly white Great Danes. GDCA may want to publish photo examples of these in future educational materials.

Information on the Irish Spotting Test (MITF-LP) and their consistency with markings (on submitted photographs) will be provided after GDCA receives MITF-LP results from VGL.

To all study participants:

We are aware that you have received MITF-LP results directly from VGL. Interpretation can be very challenging at this time, as this is a validation study.

The Team at VGL continues to investigate results, with input from the GDCA experts, on those results which are ambiguous. A clearer understanding will come from this study when it has been completed.

As the study is ongoing it is not recommended to use preliminary study data on your dogs when weighing breeding decisions.

PERFORMANCE/COMPANION REPORT

It is exciting that performance and companion events are ramping up again after the understandably slower competition year of 2020. I hope our Danes are getting out again regularly to compete and represent our breed!

As an FYI, there will not be a FastCAT trial at the 2021 National Speciality. The reason is because the host site could not accommodate the trial. It was decided by the GDCA Board of Directors that FastCAT would only be offered at the National if it could be held at the host show site.

The GDCA Board of Directors, at their last meeting, approved and disapproved a few changes to the performance/companion events annual awards and rankings.

- 1- Annual awards for virtual rally and virtual obedience will only be offered for competition years 2020 and 2021.
- 2- Major changes were made to the annual awards for agility! Preferred and Regular will now be divided. Master and Excellent will now be divided. So there will now be 8 agility rankings and annual awards. Previously there were 3 agility annual awards. The 8 agility annual awards are Regular Novice, Regular Open, Regular Excellent, Regular Master, Preferred Novice, Preferred Open, Preferred Excellent, and Preferred Master. This will begin in competition year 2021.
- 3- I asked the board to offer an annual award for Beginner Novice Obedience, since we have a significant number of Danes

competing in that class and offer that class at the National. The Board voted not to offer that award.

4- The Board voted that all AKC recognized titles should be listed in the dog's AKC registered name when listing any GDCA rankings or annual awards.

I would like to encourage all Dane owners to get out and try a performance or companion event! There are many events you can try with a Dane. Many people know about obedience, rally, and agility, but there are other great events you can participate in with a Dane. FastCAT, Scent Work, Dock Diving, Barn Hunt, Farm Dog, Carting, and many more. There are even multiple types of Canine Good Citizen awards, Temperament Test certificate, Trick Dog, and much more. More information can be found on the AKC website. There is nothing like the joy of working together with your dog as a team and watching your dog think and work!

Funeral services will be held Wednesday for Sylvia Florence Rodwell, a longtime local resident who passed away March 31 at the age of 85.

Sylvia lived in the Sun City community for 21 years, after spending 17 years as a Canyon Lake resident. She was a professional dog handler for 44 years and is ranked as the No. 1 dog handler of all time, with 37 consecutive titles in showing and handling Great Danes.

Born on Oct. 10, 1935 in Kensington, England, Sylvia and her husband moved to Canada when she was 17. Finding the cold climate too much like their native England, the couple set out for the U.S., riding a Harley Davidson motorcycle down the west coast. The couple settled in Long Beach.

After they were victims of a robbery, Sylvia's husband bought three Great Danes to protect his wife and their home. A handler who saw the great condition of their dogs encouraged their work with the Great Danes, and the couple began showing the dogs. This continued after they moved to Garden Grove. Eventually, Sylvia moved to Canyon Lake and then Sun City.

Sylvia is survived by her daughter, Teresa Gershon of Naples, Florida, and two grandchildren. Services will be held in the Skyrose Tent at Rose Hills Memorial Park in Whittier, 3888 Workman Mill Road, Wednesday at 9 a.m.



If your dog was a participant in the semen collection clinic at the Virginia Beach National Specialty in October of 2019 <u>OR</u> at the Great Dane Club of Northern California Independent Specialty in April 2019, you will be receiving a package from Dr. Stuart Meyers and his team at the University of California, Davis, School of Veterinary Medicine soon. The next step in his study involves needing a cheek swab of that same dog, done by you or your personal vet, and returning it to his lab as soon as that has been completed. All necessary materials and prepaid postage will be included in that package.

The Great Dane Club of America Charitable Trust thanks you for your willingness to participate in the largest fertility study ever done for one breed of Purebred Dogs. 




OFA Echocardiograms Subsidized By The GDCA Charitable Trust "UPDATE for 2021" **
